

Grand Master's Report Roland Perry 'Rawhide'

Tips for Hares when setting future runs:-

- 1. Please be reminded that drinking alcohol is illegal in all PUBLIC places e.g. roads, streets, footpaths, schools, temples, government offices, parks etc. So find proper private places for parking and running the circle.
- 2. If you park and start the run from a restaurant, make sure you explain to the owner that we'll have a beer truck supplying small quantity of sponsored beers (not buy and sell) to Hashers after the run. We will drink more beers at the restaurant while we have dinner.
- 3. It's illegal to throw (trash) shredded papers on the streets especially in densely populated areas. So please use tapioca flour and chalk instead. On the outskirts or in rainy seasons, you may use shredded papers wisely by putting them on lamp posts/electricity poles.

Yeti mugs now have a full yellow logo rather than an outline thanks to Spinning Dwarf's observation that the full colour logos can also be printed as arranged for the Monday Hash. All Yeti mugs will now have the colour logo (see last photo above). However, plane "silver" Yeti mugs were found by BMH3 to be prone to rust. Hence mugs should ordered in colour where the metal is protected by a coloured lacquer coating - which can still wear away at the base - probably why the mugs come with a basal rubber covering. They also come with a metal straw, useful protection against dogs but not to be carried on planes! Note - some hashers prefer the Yeti mugs over the pewter mugs since the handles can put undue strain on the wrist.




